## **EVERGREEN CLASSIC RULES AND INFORMATION**

CLOSING OF ENTRIES: Entries close JULY 17, 2025.

ENTRY PROCEDURES: One check per owner. Exhibitors may pay either by check or credit card. Exhibitors may also enter online by credit card at www.showgroundslive.com.

- 1) Exhibitors may elect to pre-pay all show fees before the closing date of entries.
- 2) Exhibitors may pay the total of:
  - 1.) A deposit fee of \$50 per horse.
  - 2.) All stall and tack room fees.
- 3) If the entry blanks are postmarked on or before the closing date of entries AND are properly filled out, the \$50 entry deposit will be credited to the entries due. LATE AND / OR IMPROPER ENTRIES WILL FORFEIT THE ENTRY DEPOSIT FEE.

#### TO BE COMPLETE ENTRY FORMS MUST INCLUDE:

- 1.) HORSE'S NAME AND COMPLETE DESCRIPTIONS
- 2.) ALL CLASSES OR SECTIONS ENTERED
- 3.) ALL MANDATORY SIGNATURES
- 4.) ORGANIZATION MEMBERSHIP NUMBERS
- 4) Trainers and owners may leave a signed, open check or credit card authorization for charges during show. All show accounts are to be closed by 5:00 p.m. Sunday.
- 5) ALL ÊNTRIES WHICH ARE LATE WILL BE ASSESSED A \$50 LATE FEE. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- 6) Exhibitors will receive their prize money within three weeks after the Horse Show.
- 7) Office fee of \$50 will be charged for each entry.

CREDIT CARDS: Exhibitors wishing to pay by credit card will be charged a 4% convenience fee. Charges to credit cards come through on statements from the Washington State Hunter Jumper Association (WSHJA).

USHJA HORSE REGISTRATIONS: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-11) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions.

CREDENTIALS: Exhibitors must present the following credentials to the horse show.

- 1) USEF / USHJA membership card
- 2) USEF / USHJA amateur certification
- 3) USEF / USHJA Large, Small, Junior Hunter & Pony measurement card
- 4) USEF / USHJA horse recording
- 5) EC membership Card

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS: Entries must be paid by draft payable in US Funds or check on Canadian US Dollar account. Canadian checks with US Funds written on the face of the check will not be accepted.

POST ENTRIES & SCRATCHES: Refunds for scratched classes only provided if show office is notified before the class starts.

HUNTER / EQ /JUMPER NOMINATING FEE: Horses or ponies entered in any hunter, jumper or equitation classes at this show must pay a \$50 Hunter / EQ/Jumper Nomination Fee. This fee allows exhibitors to add / scratch classes up to 4:00 p.m. the day before. CLASSES MUST BE ENTERED DAILY BY 4:00pm.

SUBSTITUTIONS: With a vets certificate, a new horse may be substituted for a scratched horse. Added/scratched classes will be treated under Post Entries & Scratches. There will be a \$50 office charge.

CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES AND REFUNDS: Entries cancelled after the closing date shall forfeit the entry fee, except in the case of disability of a horse, when entries shall be refunded on presentation to the Show Secretary, a certificate of disability from a qualified veterinarian PRIOR to the first class in which the horse is entered.

- 1) No refunds of entry fees shall be made after the first class in which the horse is entered unless a certificate of disability is presented to the horse show office.
- 2) There will be a \$50 office charge.
- 3) No refund of stall fees unless requested directly to the show secretary before ENTRY DUE DATE.
- 4) Refunds will be mailed within three weeks after the Horse Show.

RETURNED CHECKS/CREDIT CARDS: There will be a penalty of \$75 per charge returned by the bank for any reason. No checks/credit cards will be processed through the bank a second time. To retain entries, the fees and penalty must be paid by 4:00 p.m. the day before the Horse Show starts. In the event a check / credit card is returned after the completion of the show, it will be handled in accordance with USEF GR913. No personal checks will be cashed at the Show. Please plan accordingly.

OPPORTUNITY CLASSES: Opportunity classes are exempt from the USEF Membership, USHJA Membership, Non-member Fee, USHJA Support Fee and US EQUESTRIAN Fee.

## EVERGREEN CLASSIC RULES AND INFORMATION

USEF FEE: For every horse participating in any competition recognized by the USEF, a \$23 USEF fee will be collected (\$15 shall be a Drugs & Medication fee to provide for research, inspection and enforcement of rules regarding use of medications and drugs; see GR407.1, .2 and .3).

USHJA SUPPORT FEE: Every horse and pony entered will be assessed a \$10 USHJA Support Fee. For every Outreach horse and pony, there will be a \$5 USHJA Outreach Support Fee.

SHOW PASS FEE: Effective 12-1-2022 any rider, handler, driver, or owner are limited to one Show Pass purchase annually (December 1-November 30). USEF Show Pass will be available for purchase by exhibitors on-line only. Competitions should not accept payment for show pass fees and therefore this fee should not appear on the entry blank. Individuals, including parents who are signing as trainer on behalf of a minor, who are participating as a trainer or coach are not eligible for a Show Pass and must obtain a Senior Competing membership to participate in a USEF-licensed competition.

USHJA OUTREACH MEMBERSHIPS: There are no membership requirements to enter any Outreach class. Riders wishing to earn points in any class indicated as Outreach must be a USHJA member at the Outreach level (or higher) on or before the day of competition. USHJA Outreach membership is FREE. Please include your USHJA Membership ID on your entry.

MEASUREMENT AND AMATEUR CERTIFICATION: All Small, Small Junior, and Pony Hunters must possess and present a current measurement card to the show secretary before numbers may be picked up. If the cards are not available, measurement at the show will be required. Photocopies of current Amateur Certification or Junior Memberships may be included with entries or made available when picking up numbers.

MANAGEMENT: Management reserves the right to cancel or combine any classes that do not fill. See USEF Rule HU166 for specific information about combining/dividing for each rated section. Equitation classes not filling may be combined with the next age group. Notice will be given to exhibitors affected. Management reserves the right to start the first class of any session 30 minutes earlier than the scheduled time if entries warrant. Management reserves the right to make changes of arenas, judges, or class orders to facilitate time schedule and conditions.

COMBINED CLASSES & SECTIONS: Any class or section that does not have at least three entries will be combined. Junior, Amateur Owner, Children's and Adult Amateur Sections will be combined with fewer than four entries.

RIBBONS AND PRIZE MONEY:Ribbons will be awarded to eight places in all Hunter, Jumper and Equitation classes. Hunter Prize money to be offered Hunter and Jumper prize money will be divided as follows: 30%, 25%, 20%, 15%, 10%. 2'6" Hunter Derby and Mini Prix prize money will be divided as follows: 30%, 22%,15%,10%,7%,6%,5%,5%.

HORSE SHOW OFFICE: Show office hours:

Day Preceding Show: 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Days of Horse Show: 7:00 a.m. to 1/2 hour after end of show.

STABLING: Temporary 10' x 10' box stalls with doors on gravel flooring provided. Bagged shavings will be available for purchase during the show. Stalls will be available beginning at 10am on Tuesday prior to start day. Stalls must be vacated no later than 7pm Sunday, day after final show day. Fee for box is \$360 per stall fee for the week and \$275 for the weekend (Fri-Sun). Please indicate arrival and departure date and who you are to be stabled with on the entry blank. Anyone staying until Monday will be charged an extra \$50. Exhibitors do their own stall cleaning. No stall refunds will be given unless requested to the show secretary prior to entry closing date. Refunds after those dates will only be made if the stall is reissued to another entry.

EXHIBITORS WISHING TO BE STABLED WITH A SPECIFIC STABLE MUST HAVE THEIR ENTRIES IN BY JULY 26, 2024.

HAUL-INS: There will be a \$50 per horse fee for haul-ins.

PHOTOGRAPHY FEE: There will be a \$60 per horse fee per week. Haul-Ins will be charged \$25 per horse. This fee will enable exhibitors download access to to their entire photo library during the week. Photos will be fully edited with online resolution for social media use.

NON-SHOWING HORSE: There will be a \$125 fee for a non-showing horse on the showgrounds. A back number will be issued in the Show Office. SHARPS CONTAINERS: Sharps containers will be placed at the end of each barn aisle.

MEASUREMENTS: Vet is scheduled for measurements of horses and ponies 2:00pm Thursday of each show.

SHAVINGS & MANURE DISPOSAL FEE: There will be an \$60 per horse shavings & manure disposal fee.

SCHOOLING AND EXERCISE: Schooling areas will be available for use before, during, and after the show. Schooling in the performance rings will be allowed on Wednesday over a posted course in the Covered Ring from 9:00am to 4:00pm, in Main Outdoor from 9:00am to 5:00pm and Small Outdoor from 9:00am to 5:00pm. All schooling will be charged a \$40 fee. Hard hats must be worn while schooling.

OUTREACH SCHOOLING & EXERCISE: Schooling areas will be available for use before, during and after the show. Schooling in the show ring will be allowed on Friday, at end of Rated show schedule. A mandatory schooling fee of \$30 will be charged to all entries. Hard hats must be worn while schooling.

EXCESSIVE LUNGEING: Lungeing a visibly exhausted horse; lunging an obviously lame horse; chasing a horse with a lunge whip or other inappropriate use of the whip; the use of a lunge whip with any type of appendage or attachment, including but not limited to bags and flags; excessive and/or disruptive cracking of the whip have all now been added to the list of prohibited acts under the Horse Welfare rules for Hunters, Jumpers, and Hunter/Jumper Seat Equitation per EQ104.1, HU100.1, and JP102.2 (#249-22).

BIO-SECURITY: GR 870 states "All riders, drivers, vaulters, handlers, owners, trainers, coaches, grooms, agents and lessors must abide by and comply with biosecurity measures and equine health requirements imposed by the Federation, Competition Management, and local, state, and federal animal health officials".

GR 873 requires fevers (unexplained temperatures above 101.50 F at rest) to be reported to the competition veterinarian and competition management no later than two hours after detection. The veterinarian will evaluate the case and determine how to proceed. The febrile horse will also be reported to the Federation, specifically to and to Dr. Katie Flynn, the Equine Health and Biosecurity Veterinarian.

## EVERGREEN CLASSIC RULES AND INFORMATION

PER GR845, HORSES ENTERING THE GROUNDS FOR THE WSHJA HORSE SHOWS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY DOCUMENTATION OF EQUINE INFLUENZA VIRUS(EIV) AND EQUINE HERPESVIRUS(EHV) VACCINATIONS WITHIN SIX MONTHS PRIOR TO ENTERING THE SHOW GROUNDS.

MOTORIZED VEHICLES: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind, including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles, on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

HELMETS: It is compulsory for all persons at Federation licensed hunter, jumper, or hunter/jumper competitions when mounted anywhere on the competition grounds, to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials), SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. It is compulsory for riders in Paso Fino classes, both open and breed restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when jumping anywhere on the competition grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing and Materials), SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. A Show Committee must bar riders without protective headgear from entering the ring for classes in which protective headgear is required and may bar entry or person from entering the ring if not suitably presented to appear before an audience. (GR801)

TRAILER OR CAMPER HOOK-UPS: Trailer and camper hook-ups are available at a cost of \$350/week for power/water and \$450/week for power/water/septic. A card will be issued at the horse show office and must be displayed in a window facing the parking area. Hook-ups will be patrolled and enforced. There will be a charge of \$125/week for trailers and campers that park overnight but do not use hook-ups. *Anyone staying over until Monday will be charged an extra* \$50.

ARENAS & FOOTING: Covered arena 150' x 300', Main Hunter 250' x 255', Hunter 2 150' x 220'. The schooling arena is 100 x 200. The footing is sand. There are mulitple lunging areas on property with sand footing.

CONDITIONS OF COMPETITION: Every class offered herein, which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current Federation Rule Book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT: Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A non-member may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, or agent, at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes

REMINDER: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. 

First St. and continue 0.7 miles; make right (between Windermere and Warrior Quick Stop gas station) onto Douglas Munro Blvd., stay on this road as it quickly turns left and proceed 0.7 miles past cemetery to entrance to the Horse Park.






